




## Getting Your Home Ready For New Flooring

Floor installations can feel overwhelming—but at Hadinger Flooring, we make them simple. This guide will help you prepare your space to avoid delays, reduce extra costs, and ensure a smooth, stress-free process. Remember - a little prep goes a long way!

### PREP YOUR SPACE

- Furniture.** When arranged in advance, our installers can move standard household furniture such as sofas, beds, dressers, tables, and bookshelves. Please remove all small items and clear surfaces beforehand.
- Electronics.** Unplug and disconnect all electronic devices, including TVs, computers, lamps, speakers, and smart home equipment. These items must be removed from the installation area prior to arrival.
- Appliances & Toilets.** Gas and water appliances must be disconnected and reconnected by the appropriate licensed professionals. Installers will remove toilets by request, but reconnection must be completed by a licensed plumber.
- Bedrooms.** Remove all linens, pillows, and items stored under the bed. Please note: adjustable or mechanical beds require special handling and will incur additional charges.
- Walls & Hallways.** Remove photos, artwork, drapes, mirrors, and other hanging decor to and from the installation area. Pathways must be clear to allow for safe movement of furniture, materials, and equipment.
- Closets.** Clear all items from closet floors, including shoes, bins, and personal belongings, and remove any low-hanging items within 3 feet. Ensure closet doors can open fully.
- Pets & Children.** Clean any soiled areas prior to installation and remove litter boxes, bedding, and toys. For safety, pets and children must be kept away from the work area throughout the entire installation process.

### BEFORE INSTALLATION DAY

-  **Climate Control.** Ensure your home is climate-controlled (AC on) for at least 24–48 hours before installation and during the process. This helps materials acclimate properly.
-  **Lighting & Power.** Ensure electricity is on and work areas are well-lit so installation can be completed safely and efficiently.
-  **Entry & Access.** Confirm access (gates, codes, parking, etc.)

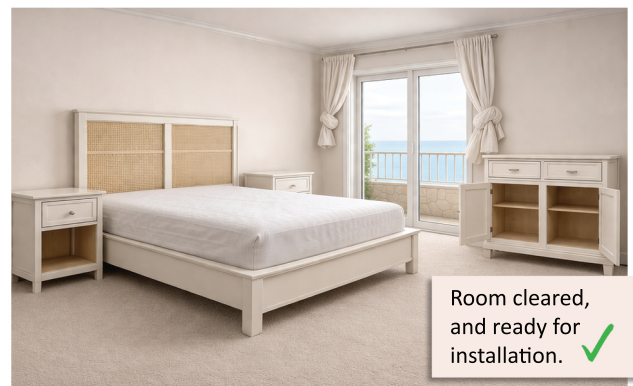
